Day 1

Today you will leave the United States on a trans-continental flight to Tel Aviv, Israel. Your flight departs late in the afternoon and arrives in Israel the morning of the next day.

Day 2

Arrive in Israel | Caesarea Maritima | Mt. Carmel | Valley of Armageddon | Megiddo | Nazareth | arrive on the Sea of Galilee

You begin the day by driving up the coast to the ancient port of Caesarea Maritima. You will see the ancient capital of the Romans in Palestine with the great theatre, hippodrome and harbor. The events of Acts 12 took place here; the Apostle Paul's imprisonment, his bringing the gospel to the house of Cornelias, and the occasion of Herod being struck by worms in the theatre. A short distance away you will see the incredible aqueducts built by Herod the Great and a later period Crusader fortress nearby. After a short drive along the coast you begin the climb up the Carmel Mountains to the heights of Mt. Carmel where Elijah slew the prophets of Baal. The view of the Valley of Armageddon will take your breath away as you recall the prophecies of Revelation and the end time events that will take place in that vast plain. You will descend into the valley and visit Megiddo, Solomon's ancient chariot city where you will view "Ahab's Water Tunnel" the hidden water source of the Israelites during the days of the divided kingdom. You cross the entire valley and begin the climb through the lower Galilean Mountains to Nazareth, the childhood home of Jesus. Leaving Nazareth you drive through the place of the villages of His day such as Cana, where He turned the water into wine. Finally, you arrive at your beautiful hotel on the shore of the Sea of Galilee where you will have dinner and spend the first of three nights.

Day 3

Sea of Galilee | Jesus Boat | Mount of Beatitudes | Tabgha | Capernaum | Lunch by the Sea | Baptism

You will wake to a breath-taking sunrise on the Sea of Galilee. After breakfast, enjoy a boat ride and time of worship on the Sea of Galilee as you sail to Nof Ginnosar in a replica of an ancient boat. The authentic 2,000-year-old boat of antiquity dates to the time of Christ. You will follow the steps of Jesus through the Galilee region as you visit the Mt. of Beatitudes and ancient Capernaum, Tabgha and the ancient fisherman's landing called the "Primacy of Peter." You will enjoy lunch by the Sea of Galilee where you will have an opportunity to eat "St. Peter's fish," tilapia, caught fresh out of the waters of the Galilee. The group will complete the day with the opportunity for baptism in the Jordan River. After this wonderful day, you can once again relax at your hotel on the Sea of Galilee. After dinner you may enjoy looking out over this beautiful lake to reflect on what you are already experiencing; walking where Jesus walked.

Day 4

Tel Dan | Bental | Dan Nature Reserve | Caesarea Philippi | Northern Golan Heights

The beautiful northern mountains of Israel await you today. At Tel Dan, there is a city gate from the time of Abraham along with an altar from the days of Israel's divided kingdom. You will get to walk through an incredible nature reserve at Dan where you will see the beginnings of the Dan River, which joins with other streams to form the Jordan River. The water is crystal-clear and pure. You will see a gorgeous waterfall as the headwaters of the Jordan River cascade into a beautiful mountain stream. Your next stop will be the site of the Apostle Peter's confession of Christ at Caesarea Philippi. You will see the second source of the Jordan River at Banias. You will hear an explanation of Israel's incredible history from 1948 until the present as you stand upon the heights of the extant volcano peak. You can see the Golan Heights spanning from the Northern border to the Sea of Galilee and learn about the strategic importance this region has played and will continue to play to the nation of Israel. After your day in the mountains, you will retire to your hotel on the Sea of Galilee for a final evening.

Day 5

Gideon Springs | Bet She'an | Qumran | Dead Sea

This morning you will have an early check-out from your hotel and leave the beautiful Sea of Galilee, following alongside the Gilboa mountain range. At Harrod's Springs you will see where Judge Gideon tested his men before the battle with the Midianites in the valley between Gilboa and Mt. Moreh. From there you will visit the last site before your journey down the Jordan Valley, Bet Shan. While not mentioned in the New Testament, it is an Old Testament city and the best preserved Roman city from that period in Israel today. You will have lunch, a break and then begin to descend toward the Plains of Jericho as you head to Qumran, the center of the Essenes. Qumran is home of the ancient caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. From there, you will continue south to your beautiful hotel, the David Dead Sea Spa and Resort, where you may float in the waters of the Dead Sea, the lowest spot on earth, if you desire.

Day 6

Masada | Ein Gedi | Wadi Qelt | Jerusalem – Mt. of Olives

Today you will go on to the mighty fortress Masada on the edge of the barren Negev Desert, the last stronghold and stand of the zealots against Rome. Masada is a symbol of courage and perseverance for the Jewish people, where 960 Jewish defenders organized their last resistance to the roman conquerors and took their own lives rather than surrender into slavery. From there you will continue northward in the desert where ibex roam at Ein Gedi, David's hideout from Saul. Time permitting, you will stop at Wadi Qelt to overlook the barren Judean wilderness and the Valley of the Shadow of Death. After passing by ancient Jericho, the climb to Jerusalem begins as you view scenery and travel the same route the ancient pilgrims would have taken as they made their journey to Jerusalem for the great feasts of Israel. Today you finally arrive in the City of God, the City of David and the ancient and modern capital of Israel, Jerusalem. Your heart will leap with emotion as you stand on the overlooks of the Mount of Olives and see the breathtaking Mountain of Moriah. It is there where Abraham was to offer Isaac, Solomon built the first temple, and where Jesus walked, taught, died, rose again and will one day return in great glory! This is only the beginning. You check into your hotel, have dinner and enjoy the first of four nights in your lovely hotel in Jerusalem.

Days 7-10

Jerusalem, Jerusalem, Jerusalem!

You will spend these next days in and around the environs of the capital of ancient and modern day Israel - Jerusalem! Once you arrive in Jerusalem, before disembarking each afternoon you will hear the next day's itinerary.

You will have one free day in Jerusalem to spend anyway you like.

Passport and Medical Insurance card scans (front and back) must be received by September 23, 2018.

Registrations received after Sept. 23 are late registrations and incur a late fee of \$100 per passenger. After this date, the full balance is due at the time of registration.

Cancellation penalties (see page 4) apply if cancellation takes place 90 days or less before departure date.

PRICE is as advertised, based on double occupancy. Flights are economy class.
Balance is due in full 95 days before departure.

REGISTRATION AND DEPOSIT of \$500 are due simultaneously; \$175 per passenger is non-refundable for any reason. No space is "held" without both. Only the deposit is payable online via credit card. Registrations received inside of ninety-five (95) days of departure (see inside brochure) are late and full payment is due at the time of registration. A \$150 late fee per passenger is also due.

BALANCE is due in full 95 days before departure (see brochure) payable only by check or check form. Final payments received inside of this deadline will be assessed a \$50 per passenger late payment fee. All reservations not fully paid by the deadline are subject to cancellation for which TLC Holyland Tours is not responsible.

PAYMENT by an individual or for an individual affirms your agreement to these terms and conditions. Payment must be by check, cash, or check form.

PASSPORT must be valid for a minimum of six months after your date of return from Israel, as required by Israel. (For US citizens, no visa is required by Israel.) A clear scan of your passport must be sent to TLC Holyland Tours by the time the final balance is due.

PROOF OF MEDICAL INSURANCE is required along with the passport scan. A scanned image of the front and back of your health insurance card is preferred.

TRANSPORTATION is by modern air-conditioned motor coach and by jet, economy class seating. Tickets are completed 30 days prior to departure and cannot be changed once issued. Upgrades and associated cost are the sole responsibility of the passenger after ticketing

DEVIATIONS/STOPOVERS, or any individual change in the return date that is a deviation from the basic group itinerary will **NOT** be allowed.

HOTEL costs are based on two persons sharing a twin-bedded room with private bath. Single rooms are subject to availability for an additional cost. **If a passenger cannot supply a roommate and TLC Holyland Tours, LLC is unable to do so, or your roommate cancels before departure, the passenger will have to pay the supplemental charge.** (Passenger may be billed after the final payment date for single room accommodations as necessary.)

MEALS are on half board (HB); two meals daily - breakfast and dinner at hotel with full Israeli buffet - unless otherwise noted in tour brochure. The tour host, with an extra charge, may arrange lunch meals in advance otherwise lunch cost is the responsibility of each passenger.

SIGHTSEEING is with local transportation by deluxe air-conditioned motor coach. The services of an English-speaking guide, and entrance fees to all sites visited as described in the itinerary, are included in the tour price. The actual daily itinerary is subject to adjustment at the discretion of the tour operator or their representative on the ground in Israel.

NOTE: Each passenger should be physically able to walk, get on and off the bus, go up and down stairs, walk on uneven terrain, and generally get around without assistance. Any passenger unable to do so must bring someone to assist them at their own expense.

NOT INCLUDED: Passport costs, food and beverages (including coffee and tea) not usually included with regular meals, optional tours and excursions not mentioned in this itinerary, accident and baggage insurance, transporting and handling excess luggage, and trip tips. In the event it becomes necessary to overnight material due to late receipt of registration or final payments, the traveler will be billed for these charges. Any quotes of airport taxes and/or fuel surcharges are only based on good faith estimates. Actual airport taxes and/or fuel surcharges are estimated; any increase before ticketing will be billed to each passenger as TLC Holyland Tours is billed by the taxing entity.

You will need to arrive at the airport 3½ - 4 hours before international departure time. TLC Holyland Tours is not responsible for changes to the flight schedule.

Any passenger, including host(s) personally reserving flight(s) to connect to the group at any point in the journey, is required by TLC Holyland Tours to use the airline being used by that group. TLC Holyland Tours will not be available to assist, in any way, with personal reservations or travel difficulties resulting from said reservation. If using the airline used for that group, the airline will be willing to assist the passenger if difficulties with scheduling arise.
